A Digital recording is made of each service. If you would like to borrow a CD, please ask at the P.A. desk. 

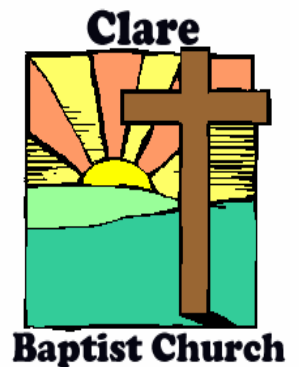

### Open Doors World Watch List 2018

Each week during 2018 we are praying for the countries on the Open Doors World Watch List. This week, we pray for persecuted Christians in the country at number 12 on the list, Saudi Arabia. The government maintains a strict Islamic system that treats Christians as second-class citizens. Please Pray

- For change in the government's initiative to reduce the number of migrant workers so jobs can go to nationals; this lowers the numbers of Christians
- For new Christians to mature and safely share their faith with relatives and Muslim Saudis
- For those in government, the royal house, and religious police to discover Jesus

**E.B.A. Weekly Prayer Focus - Melbourn B.C.** Melbourn is a large village towards the southern tip of Cambridgeshire. Melbourn B.C. is about to embark on a much-needed rebuild of their hall, thanks to an enthusiastic response by the congregation to put in place the finances to get the project moving. This will happen once the church's short-term missionaries – Brian and Janet Orrell – return from Thailand in November when Brian will lead the rebuilding programme. This autumn the church has two outreach events to look forward to - the 'Higher' event for young people at Melbourn Village College, and the follow-up at Cambridge's high profile music venue, The Junction and an Alpha course which has been prompted by an influx of parents as a result of the Holiday Bible Club, and other seekers. These activities are in addition to the regular midweek events taking place – including Toddlers Plus, Craft Morning, Coffee Break, Luncheon Club and Prayer Meetings. The church also has strong links with Royston Foodbank.

**For Prayer** - Give thanks for the sacrificial giving which has put finances in place for the rebuilding programme, and for those willing to serve on the team, join them in prayer for the 'Higher' event and the young people who will be reached by the team and for the Alpha course, that it will be warmly welcomed by those exploring the Christian faith.
