A Digital recording is made of each service. If you would like to borrow a CD, please ask at the P.A. desk.

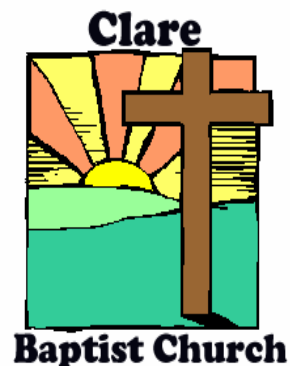
