A Digital recording is made of each service. If you would like to borrow a CD, please ask at the P.A. desk.

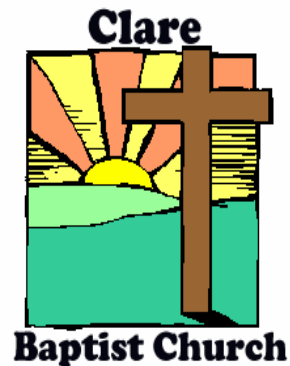

EBA Weekly Prayer Focus - Centenary B.C. Centenary B.C. is situated on the High Street of the market town of March in the Fenland area of Cambridgeshire. Since their minister retired in May 2017, the church has been led by a team of six deacons who are supported by visiting speakers. Although March may be considered a small church, it has a big heart and offers a warm welcome for all who visit. There is a monthly Café style service which was developed to encourage families that attend Chatterbox, their baby and toddler group. Since 2008, Centenary has been in partnership with Christians Against Poverty (CAP), running a volunteer debt centre which covers the whole Fenland area. Last year, they celebrated two baptisms that had come through this ministry. If that wasn't enough, Centenary also acts as the storage and distribution centre for the Food Bank.

For prayer - Please pray for Centenary B.C. as they seek the way forward during this time of pastoral vacancy and that they will hold firm to their faith and that God will provide all that they need
