A Digital recording is made of each service. If you would like to borrow a CD, please ask at the P.A. desk.

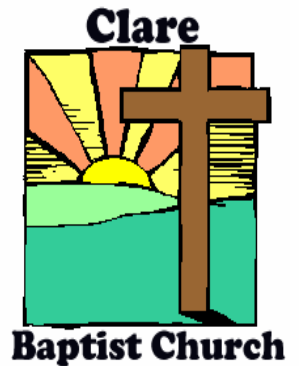

Open Doors World Watch List 2018

Each week during 2018 we are praying for the countries on the Open Doors World Watch List. This week, we pray for persecuted Christians in the country at number 25 on the list, Nepal. While the constitution states that Nepal is a secular state, it is illegal to convert to any religion other than Hinduism. Please Pray

- for all who frequently face religious persecution, both threatened and actual
- for Christians who grieve for the victims of persecution but struggle to obtain land where they can bury their dead, and often resort to burying people illegally in the forest
- for transformation of radical Hindus who have physically attacked Christians, and are able to act with impunity

E.B.A. Weekly Prayer Focus - Hutton Free Church. Hutton is midway between Brentwood and Billericay in Essex, and is a handy commute into London from nearby Shenfield station. It is also home to Hutton Free Church, whose roots go back about 160 years. It a hub for church and non-church groups and the premises are home to the local food bank. Within the past year Hutton Free Church has entered into a full church-sharing agreement with Breakthru AOG Pentecostal church, and they also now share premises with Emmanuel Church – an Evangelical Alliance church plant. With these new relationships in place, Hutton's premises are now known as The Christian Centre. Church activities include a seniors lunch club, toddlers group, sport and leisure, Bible study, The Big Sing choir for all ages, and Perform – a group which encourages child development through drama, dance and singing.

For Prayer - for the relatively new links with other churches, that a larger range of community-based initiatives can flourish, for the shared Sunday services, for a new Bible Study meeting, Growing Together – as individuals and as a church community
