COFFEE MORNING

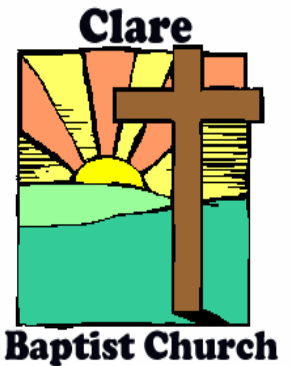

Open Doors World Watch List 2018

Each week during 2018 we are praying for the countries on the Open Doors World Watch List. This week, we pray for persecuted Christians in the country at number 33 on the list, Bhutan. No churches are officially recognised in Bhutan, so all Christian fellowships are secret churches. Please Pray

- For strength for believers who violate the anti-conversion law by leaving the Buddhist faith
- That efforts to persecute Christians will actually unite them
- That God will soften the hearts of those who know Christians and make them receptive to the gospel

EBA Weekly Prayer Focus - Neatishead B.C. Neatishead is a group of different hamlets in a rural and isolated part of the Norfolk Broads. There has been a Baptist presence there since 1811. Ian Bloomfield has been the pastor of Neatishead B.C. since May 2017, serving on a part-time basis. The church has around twenty attendees in the congregation most Sundays. Major building work to replace the ceiling of the Grade 2 listed building has just been completed, and now the builders have finished the redecoration work is currently in progress.

For Prayer - For the ministry of the church, pastor Ian Bloomfield, and the needs of the congregation, that closer links with the local community may be forged to show a strong Christian presence, that there will be greater involvement and engagement with the events and life of the church and that the whole fellowship will capture God's intent for them.
