A Digital recording is made of each service. If you would like to borrow a CD, please ask at the P.A. desk.





E.B.A. Weekly Prayer Focus - Orchard B.C., Colchester. Orchard Baptist Church is located in the south of Colchester, surrounded by several housing estates. The fellowship draws on the local community and the wider area. Sunday morning services are lively and creative, often using multi-media presentations and attracting 40-60 people. Rev. Graeme Ross was, until recently, the minister at Orchard B. C. before becoming a Regional Minister with the E.B.A. The fellowship at Orchard are beginning the process of seeking a new minister.

Orchard is a missional fellowship with their annual free Community Fun Day attended by up to 300 people. In school holidays there is either a Fun Morning or a Film Morning for local families.
